<b>Day 1 - Landing to Persia (Tehran)</b>		
Tehran	Welcome to Iran. To be met by your tour guide at the airport (IKA airport), you will be transferred to your hotel. Visit <b>Sa'adAbad</b> and <b>Niavaran Palace</b> . The <b>Sa'adAbad Palace Complex</b> was built by Qajar and Pahlavi monarchs. Today, the official residence of the President of Iran is located adjacent to the complex. In the evening we take a walk on the <b>Nature bridge</b> . Nature bridge is located in <b>Ab-o-Atash park</b> in Tehran. It has won an international prize for architectural design. The reason it is named nature bridge is that it connects 3 parks and It is one of the most popular parks in Tehran.	3-4* hotel/traditional house
<b>Day 2 – Old Part of Tehran</b>		
Tehran/Shiraz	Start the day by visiting <b>Golestan Palace*</b> , a historical complex in Iran's capital city, Tehran. This former royal Qajar complex has been inscribed in the list of UNESCO World Heritage in June 2013. Then continue visiting the <b>Grand Old Bazaar of Tehran</b> . Also, visit the <b>National Museum of Iran</b> . Depending on the time, we will take a walk under the Azadi (Liberty) tower. Then at night take a flight to Shiraz.	3-4* hotel/traditional house
<b>Day 3 - Shiraz In-depth</b>		
Shiraz	In the morning, explore the well-known city of Shiraz. Visit historical parts of Shiraz starting <b>Narenjestan historical complex</b> , then Visit <b>Nasir-ol Molk Mosque (Pink Mosque)</b> a few steps far from Narenjestan. you'll have time to explore and shop in the bustling <b>Vakil historical complex</b> (Public Bath, Bazaar, Mosque).	3-4* hotel/traditional house
<b>Day 4 - City of Roses and Nightingales</b>		
Shiraz	Today exploring Shiraz continues. Visit <b>Eram Persian Garden*</b> with its beautiful press-lined avenues leading to an elegant summer palace. Then visit the tomb of two Iranian famous poets, <b>Hafez (Hafezieh)</b> and <b>Saadi (Saadieh)</b> . Finally, visit <b>Shahcheragh Holy Shrine</b> .	3-4* hotel/traditional house
<b>Day 5 - Glory of Persia (Pasargadae)</b>		
Shiraz/Yazd	Day 5 is all about Ancient Persia. Visit ancient historical monuments such as <b>Persepolis*</b> the heart of the Persian empire and a UNESCO World Heritage site. Then visit <b>Naqsh-e Rostam</b> an ancient necropolis located about 12 km northwest of Persepolis, and en route to Taft/Yazd, visit <b>Pasargadae*</b> , the <b>tomb of Cyrus the Great</b> . At night we will arrive at Yazd.	3-4* hotel/traditional house
<b>Day 6 - Feel Adobes (Yazd)</b>		
Yazd	After having breakfast, visit the stunning City of wind towers in the middle of deserts and Zoroastrianism. <b>Tower of Silence</b> is the first visit of the day, a structure built by Zoroastrians for exarnation. Then we will visit the <b>Fire Temple of Yazd</b> . The fire temple in Zoroastrianism is the place of worship for Zoroastrians, Then, we look around the <b>Amir Chakhmaq Square</b> , a complex consisting of Tekyeh (a building where Shia Muslims gather to mourn Husayn's death in the month of Muharram), Water reservoir, mosque, and Bazaar. Then we walk around the old area of the city and visit <b>Yazd Jame mosque</b> , and Fahadan district to feel the desert architecture culture. Among the many other	3-4* hotel/traditional house

	historic sites to be seen in Yazd are beautiful old houses and the <b>Dowlat Abad Garden*</b> . Standing by the garden's long reflecting pool, you'll be shaded by <b>ancient Pine trees</b> .	
<b>Day 7 - Religions Crossway (Yazd)</b>		
<b>Yazd/Isfahan</b>	Leave Yazd to visit Isfahan in the morning. En route to Meybod visit <b>Narin Qale</b> (historical fort) and <b>Kabootar Dovecote</b> . Then in the historical city of Nain visit places including the <b>Jame mosque of Naein</b> and the <b>Historical bazaar of Naein</b> . In the afternoon, continue to Isfahan to walk around <b>Zayande Rood (River)</b> and visit some <b>historical bridges like 33-pol and Khajoo pol (Bridge)</b> . On Thursday nights, people come under Khajoo and 33 pol Bridges and sing there. Try not to lose it and enjoy it.	<b>3-4* hotel/traditional house</b>
<b>Day 8 - Half of the World</b>		
<b>Isfahan</b>	Explore Half of the World! First, visit <b>Naghsh-e Jahan Square*</b> . In Naghsh-e Jahan Square are <b>Imam Mosque*</b> , <b>Sheikh Lotfollah mosque*</b> , <b>Aliqapoo palace*</b> , and <b>Isfahan Bazaar</b> . Then in the afternoon visit the beautiful garden of <b>Bagh-e Chehel Sotoun*</b> . The name, meaning "Forty Columns" in Persian, was inspired by the twenty slender wooden columns supporting the entrance pavilion, which, when reflected in the waters of the fountain, are said to appear to be forty.	<b>3-4* hotel/traditional house</b>
<b>Day 9 - 1500 Years Old Village</b>		
<b>Isfahan/Kashan</b>	Today we leave Esfahan to visit <b>Jameh Mosque</b> , <b>Chahar Taqi</b> (Fire Temple), and the Handicraft workshop in Natanz, After lunch, we move to the historic <b>Village of Abyaneh</b> the Astonishing red village in Iran.	<b>3-4* hotel/traditional house</b>
<b>Day 10 - Kashan Through Desert</b>		
<b>Kashan</b>	In Kashan, we visit <b>Fin Persian Garden*</b> , <b>Tabatabaie historical house</b> , <b>Borujerdiha house</b> , and <b>Aghabozorg mosque</b> . If you are traveling in Spring, we do not miss the villages near Kashan for the Festival of Rose and <b>Rose Water in Qamsar and Niasar</b> .	<b>3-4* hotel/traditional house</b>
<b>Day 11 - Glory of Desert (Kashan)</b>		
<b>Kashan/Tehran</b>	Today explore the <b>Maranjab Desert</b> which is near Kashan. En route, visit The <b>Underground City of Ouyi</b> . In the Maranjab Desert enjoy the beautiful landscape of desert and dunes. After exploring the desert, move toward Tehran to stay the night at the hotel of the Imam Khomeini Airport.	<b>3-4* hotel/traditional house</b>
<b>Day 12 - Missing Persia</b>		
<b>Tehran</b>	Transfer from Hotel to IKA airport.	-
