<b>Day 1 - Landing to Persia (Tehran)</b>		
Tehran	Landing to PERSIA (Tehran). Welcome to Iran. To meet your tour guide at the airport (IKIA airport), you will be transferred to your hotel. Visit <b>Sa'dAbad</b> and <b>Niavaran Palace</b> . The Sa'dAbad Palace built by Qajar and Pahlavi monarchs. Today, the official residence of the President of Iran is located adjacent to the complex. After visiting these palaces, we visit the former USA Embassy. And in the evening we take a walk on the Nature bridge. <b>Nature bridge</b> is located in the Fire and Water (Ab o Atash) park in Tehran which is one of the most popular parks in Tehran.	4* hotel/traditional house
<b>Day 2 - The Old Part of Tehran</b>		
Tehran/Kashan	Start the day by visiting <b>Golestan Palace*</b> , a historical complex in Iran's capital city, Tehran. This former royal Qajar complex has been inscribed in the list of UNESCO World Heritage in June 2013. Then will continue our tour to the <b>Grand Old Bazaar of Tehran</b> . Also, we visit the <b>National Museum of Iran</b> . Depending on the time, we will take a walk on 30 Tir Street. We will drive to Kashan in the evening.	4* hotel/traditional house
<b>Day 3- Desert Night</b>		
Kashan	We start our sightseeing tour by visiting the historical houses of Kashan like <b>Tabatabaei and Borujerdiha historical houses</b> , and Fin Persian garden*: a relaxing and visually impressive Persian garden with water channels all passing through a central pavilion and then visit the <b>traditional Bazaar</b> and <b>Amin al-Dawla Timcheh</b> (Carvansarai) and finish the day by visiting <b>Aghabozorg mosque-religious school</b> .	4* hotel/traditional house
<b>Day 4 - Half Of The World</b>		
Kashan/Isfahan	In the morning en-route to Isfahan, visit <b>Madar Shah Caravanserai</b> . After arriving in Isfahan and checking into the hotel, we will explore Half of the World! We start with <b>Chehel Sotoun Palace*</b> . Then, in the evening, will visit <b>Siosepol and Khajoo historical bridges</b> . Also, meantime, visiting some handicrafts workshops can be managed.	4* hotel/traditional house
<b>Day 5 - Isfahan In-depth</b>		
Isfahan/Yazd	Today we have a half-city tour of Isfahan. Start the day by visiting the magnificent <b>Naghsh-e Jahan Historical Square*</b> , <b>Shah Mosque*</b> , <b>Sheikh Lotfollah Mosque*</b> , and <b>Aliqapoo Palace*</b> . Then in the afternoon drive to Yazd.	4* hotel/traditional house
<b>Day 6 - Feel Adobes</b>		
Yazd	After having breakfast, visit the stunning City of wind towers in the middle of deserts and Zoroastrianism. <b>Tower of Silence</b> is the first visit of the day, a structure built by Zoroastrians for exorcism. Then we will visit the <b>Fire Temple of Yazd</b> . The fire temple in Zoroastrianism is the place of worship for Zoroastrians, Then, we look around the <b>Amir Chakhmaq Square</b> , a complex consisting of Tekyeh (a building where Shia Muslims gather to mourn Husayn's death in the month of Muharram), Water reservoir, mosque, and Bazaar. Then we walk around the old area of the city and visit <b>Yazd Jame mosque</b> and Fahadan district to feel the desert architecture culture. Among the many other	4* hotel/traditional house

	historic sites to be seen in Yazd are beautiful old houses and the <b>Dowlat Abad Garden*</b> . Standing by the garden's long reflecting pool.	
<b>Day 7 - The Glory of Persia</b>		
<b>Yazd/Shiraz</b>	Today on the way to Shiraz we visit ancient historical monuments like <b>Persepolis*</b> , <b>Pasargadae*</b> , and <b>Naqsh-e Rostam*</b> . Persepolis* (Takht-é Jamshid), the heart of the Persian Empire and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Here, walk through a complex of palaces and temples that is said to be one of the architectural wonders of the world. Then visit Pasargadae*. Our explorations take us to the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Pasargadae* to see the impressive, elevated <b>Tomb of Cyrus</b> .	<b>4* hotel/traditional house</b>
<b>Day 8 - In-depth in Shiraz</b>		
<b>Shiraz</b>	Explore lovely Shiraz Day! The City of Roses and Nightingales. Our Shiraz journey begins with <b>Narenjestan Garden</b> , with the richly decorated pavilion featuring a mirrored porch set among graceful trees. Then will continue to <b>Arg-e Karim Khan</b> (a citadel located in downtown Shiraz, and in shape, it resembles a medieval fortress). Late this afternoon, spend some time in the <b>Vakil Historical Complex</b> (public bath, bazaar, mosque) and famous <b>Shiraz Bazaar</b> (Shiraz shopping paradise). After that, we start in the <b>tomb of two Iran's greatest poets, Hafez and Saadi</b> . And continue to Eram Garden*, with its beautiful cypress-lined avenues leading to an elegant summer palace and <b>Nasir-ol-Molk Mosque</b> (Pink Mosque).	<b>4* hotel/traditional house</b>
<b>Day 9 - Welcome to Persian Gulf</b>		
<b>Shiraz/ Bandar Abbas</b>	Early in the morning, we move to <b>Bandar Abbas</b> . In the evening we will arrive there.	<b>4* hotel/traditional house</b>
<b>Day 10 - Excursion in Qeshm Island</b>		
<b>Bandar Abbas/ Qeshm</b>	Today After walking around Bandar Abbas, we take a ferry to Qeshm Island and have excursions in <b>Qeshm</b> . Visit <b>Qeshm Bazaar, Portuguese Castle, and Khourbas Cave</b> .	<b>4* hotel/traditional house</b>
<b>Day 11 - Excursion In Hengam Island</b>		
<b>Qeshm/Hengam</b>	Today is one of the most exciting days of the Qeshm trip. In the morning before 9 o'clock, we go for a boat tour. Visit the <b>famous dolphins</b> of Qeshm, the Natural Aquarium, and the beauties of Hengam island with its colored sands. For lunch, use island local foods like Falafel and Samosa. Then visit <b>Local Bazaar</b> and do a <b>temporary Tattoo in Hana color</b> . Afterward, we Visit the Valley of the Stars and go to Hotel. On this day, we try to listen to some local music if possible. If we're lucky, in late winter (March) and spring, we may have this chance to see the <b>Hawksbill sea turtle</b> and how they lay eggs and maybe even we get to see how the baby turtles hatch eggs in Qeshm.	<b>4* hotel/traditional house</b>
<b>Day 12 - Jewelry of Persian Gulf</b>		
<b>Qeshm/Hormoz/ Tehran</b>	Day 9 is all about Hormuz island. In the morning after breakfast, we go to the island's quay. From there, our journey to the beautiful island of Hormuz begins. On this one-day tour, we visit the <b>Rainbow Mountains</b> , The <b>Valley of the Statues</b> , the <b>Silver and Red Beaches of Hormuz</b> , and the <b>Red Clay mine of Hormuz</b> . Depending on the time of the flight, we leave for Tehran.	<b>4* hotel/traditional house</b>
